**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the District shall accept written public comment on the budget proposals from September 19, 2026 at 8:00 a.m. until October 20, 2026 at 11:00 a.m. The District shall take oral public comment, which may be accompanied by submitted materials, at the meeting referenced above before any decision is taken on the budget and supplemental budget.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors is hereby instructed to proceed with all necessary notifications, posting and publications of the draft 2026 budget amendment and draft 2027 budget by or on September 19, 2026. Payment for such publication is authorized.

**WHEREAS**, RCW 86.15.140 includes provisions for supplemental budgets reflecting any increased or different expenditures and revenues not noted in the original budget, to be adopted through a duly publicized hearing and a majority vote of the supervisors; and

**WHEREAS**, based on information more current than at the time of the original budget's estimates, an amendment is advisable to conform the financial accounts and records of the district to the actual funding received for revenues and expenditures; and

**WHEREAS**, all members of the board of supervisors of the Chehalis River Basin Flood Control Zone District have had reasonable notice of time, place and purpose of this meeting and of the proposed budget amendment;
