#### **Project update**

Matt Dillin provided updates regarding the project. Matt said initial investigation on upstream and downstream minimization alignments has been completed. Matt said both alignments appear feasible from a constructability standpoint. Additionally, the construction phase fish passages appear to be feasible from a conceptual level. He said the District has sought input from the tribes as to which alignment is preferable. The tribes have been reluctant to choose an option they feel would best mitigate impacts. The District has

decided to advance the upstream minimization alignment as this alignment appears to do the best job at minimizing impacts to the Traditional Cultural Property according to the information that is currently available to the District.

J Vander Stoep provided updates on behalf of the Office of the Chehalis Basin Board.

## **Land Owner Engagement**

Matt Dillin said that Washington State Parks is working on an agreement to purchase Marwood Farms. The Office of Chehalis Basin may be a partner in the purchase. This would be an extremely valuable property for mitigation of the FRE due to its location near the confluence with the South Fork and the participation of adjacent land owners. Dave said the parcel is close to 180 acres.
